**Description:**

A French tapestry depicting in a bucolic atmosphere the first stage in wine making (gathering the grapes before extracting the juice). The workers, or peasants, bring basketful of white grapes and tumble their contents into a big vat, constructed of oak like a wide open barrel. The whole scene is depicted onto the background of a river behind which the village houses scale a wooded hill. The landscape is probably inspired by burgundy, rather than other wine-making regions in France. 5'11 wide x 8' high
