Description:

Among the most classical of the revival period Tabriz carpet designs is that of the garden design pattern. This divides the field into small panels each with a garden motif: trees shrubs animals. The trees include cypress weeping willow plane and flowered plum. Animals include goats and sheep. The four sections are divided by crossing bands which repeat a carpet in miniature. More cypresses and flowering trees fill the border. This carpet is a modern interpretation of a classic Persian pattern whose origin lies in the early 17th century.
